



# Circava drops vs. Allergy shots

## *Which is right for you?*

|  | Circava System               | Allergy Shots   |
|--|------------------------------|---|
| # of office visits required (first year)                 | 5 visits                     | 40+ visits  |
| # of skin injections required (first year)               | 0                            | 160+  |
| Adverse side effects                                     | Rare, mild                   | >28% including the possibility of anaphylaxis reaction        |
| Average time to reach maintenance & clinical improvement | 23 days                      | 244 days  |
| % of patients who reach maintenance                      | 84%                          | 22%   |
| Suitable for patient taking beta blockers                | Yes                          | No  |
| Safe for children 3 1/2 years of age                     | Yes                          | No  |
| Restarting treatment after interruption                  | Non-problematic              | Difficult, causes setbacks in schedule, delays treatment time |
| Time of day for treatment:                               | Nighttime, Bedtime           | Daytime, Work hours   |
| Post-treatment supervision:                              | First visit only, 10 minutes | After each shot, 20 – 30 minutes                              |
